At VetRelieve we are committed to keeping our environmental footprint as low as possible.

Re-use and Recycle

We are proud to be the only pet bedding company in the UK to offer an end-of-life recycling service.

Foam products especially are difficult to recycle and many foams end up in landfill. Here at VetRelieve, we want the foam in our beds to be in service for as long as possible, before being recycled to the highest market standard.

That's why we introduced our 'R&R' scheme. At the end of your need for your pet's bed or mattress, simply contact us to request a recycling slip.

Pop your bed in the post, and we will refurbish it and redistribute it to animal charities in need of bedding for resident animals or to pet foster carers.

If you've left a review of your bed on Google or Trip Advisor, this service is free! Otherwise, we ask for a £10 fee to cover the costs of the refurbishment and redistribution.

For beds returned to us that are non-salvageable, we recycle the foam through a third-party provider to prevent the foam from going to landfill.

UK Manufacturing

All our products are made in the UK – we don't ship any products from abroad. This vastly reduces our carbon footprint, as well as helping with agile production. And you have the peace of mind that every stitch, cur or weld was done in South Yorkshire.

Saved From Incineration

The tags on our beds are made of leather which we save from being incinerated.

We work directly with the factory that produces the offcuts to make sure we know exactly where our leather is coming from.

Paper Reduction

We have moved many of our care instructions online, and our clinical VetRest Duo mattresses come with NFC tags to scan which contain the care instructions. This vastly reduces our use of printed information.
